Portfolio Site — project preparation

With the course now nearing its end – your last major project is your own portfolio site – your new online presence to present and promote yourself and your talent and skills. Over the Easter break – take time to sketch out design ideas for your own site – follow the steps below and record your findings and ideas.

- **content collection and planning**

collect your portfolio content – take screenshots of online work, scan or photograph sketches and rough – write any text you want to show.

- **design development – brain storming, ideas and roughs**

before you research deeper into portfolio sites – take some time to sit down and produce a few ideas, work in a sketchbook (buy one if you don't already have one) and just go with the flow – drawing out all and any ideas coming to mind – regardless of their quality or relevance.

- **design development – refining roughs**

choose one or two of our ideas and produce a rough mockup for discussion in class.

outstanding projects

Make sure to catch up on any outstanding projects – complete your client projects if you can – and there are still a few essays and most scrapbook projects still outstanding. I will be doing your assessments over the holidays and we will need to start wrapping things up as time will fly by till the end of the course now.
